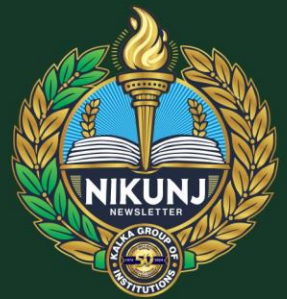

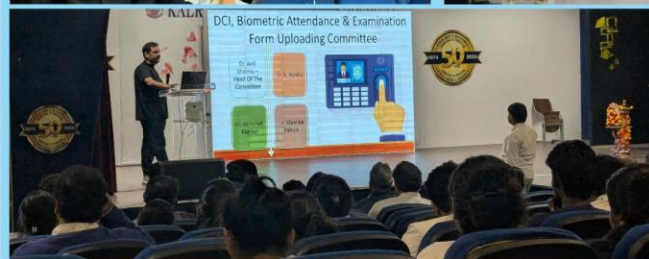

On 26th November kalka dental college celebrated " National Constitution Day" as per the directives of ABVMU, Lucknow.



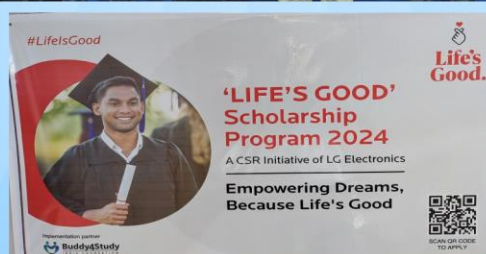
TALENT HUNT COMPETITION

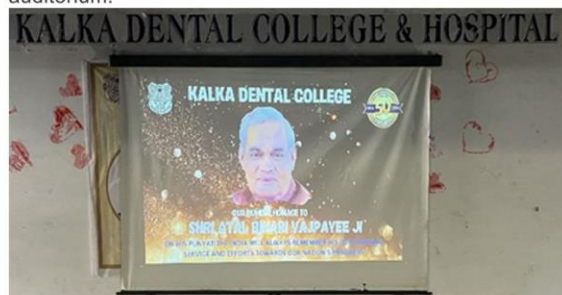
BREAST FEEDING WEEK CELEBRATION

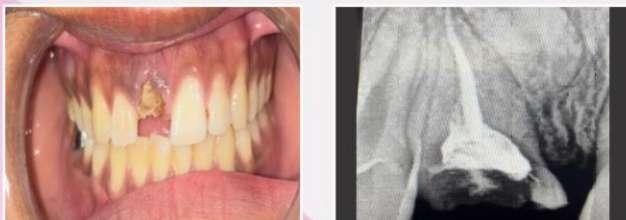

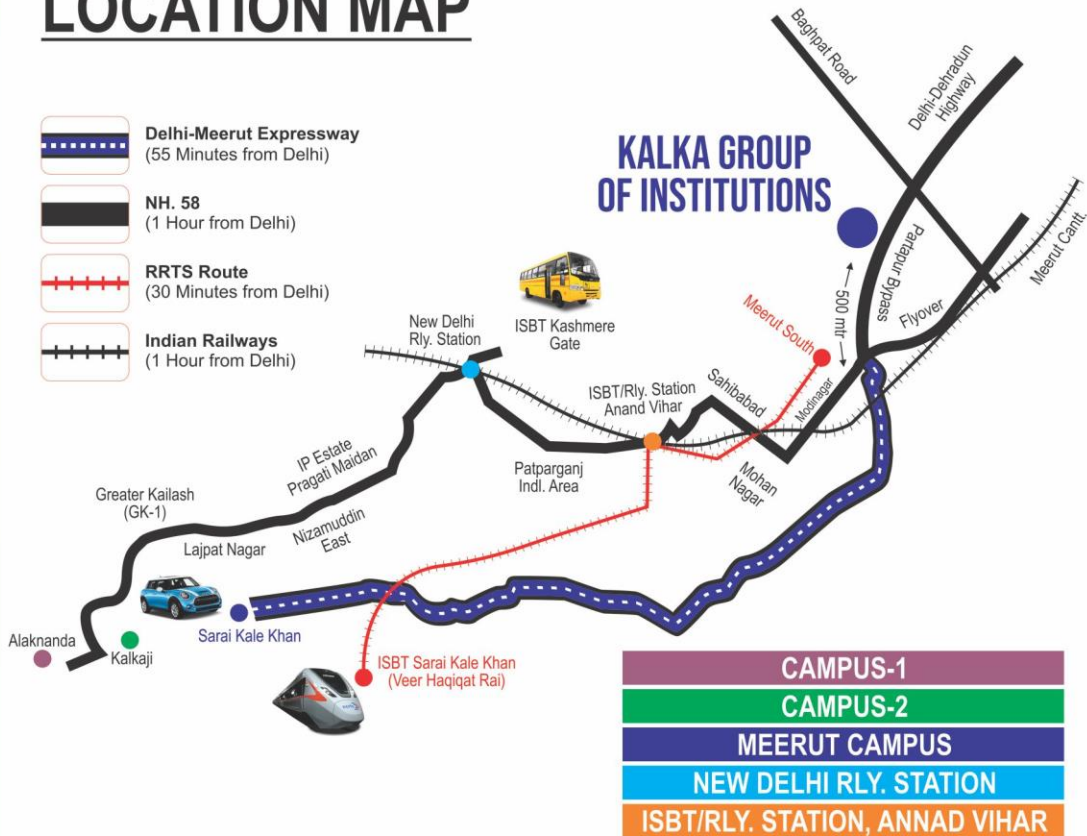
